She is hoping to visit our class on Thursday 8th December with some of her beautiful creations, some of which may be available to purchase. A big 'thank you' to Leila for sharing this with us.....

Leïla Weston's hobby turned into obsession:

When I arrived in England, from France, more than 30 years ago, I was blown away, among other things, by the beauty of the period houses' front door with their leaded glass.

When my husband and I bought an Edwardian house, my intension was to re-insert the Stained Glass panel in the front door.

Teaching French during the day, I joined an evening class to learn the art of making Stained Glass. It was still possible then!

After my first lesson, I was hooked! I loved it! After a few months of hard work and many plasters on my fingers, I managed to produce my front door and its side panel. Then, unable to stop, I carried on with other places in the house. I even had a cupboard specially built in an alcove so that I could add Stained Glass panels in its doors.

I wanted to take my hobby further; therefore I took a year off French teaching and joined a full time course at college to get a diploma in Designing and Making Stained Glass. I went back to teaching, as it is more lucrative and regular than Art making, but I started taking commissions. I have now installed Stained Glass panels in schools but mainly in my friends and neighbours' front doors, working through word of mouth.
