


2018 - What a fabulous Dancezing Year it's been!

This year I was delighted to be able to visit Diana's art exhibition at Denbies and oh, what a treat!


Diana is very talented and produces many different types of works of art, painting different subjects, using a variety of styles & materials, and implementing different techniques.
