



If you think that spring time in Eastbourne with lots of dancing and socialising with friends sounds great, then you will no doubt enjoy our line dance weekend break ©

This hotel is located around 1^{1/2} hrs away by car and just over 1hr by train from East Croydon Station. The hotel rooms are clean and comfortable & we received good customer service when we stayed there previously. Parking vouchers are available for a small sum for on street parking. There is a good sized dance floor.

Eastbourne is known for its high sunshine levels © There is plenty to do and see – Eastbourne Bandstand, walks along the promenade, visit Beachy Head or Seven Sisters Country Park, a shopping centre just ten minutes' walk away, Eastbourne pier, to name just a few.

2 nights with bed, breakfast and evening meal. A fun-filled weekend of line dancing, laughter and socialising. Dance socials on Friday and Saturday evenings as well as Sunday morning. (I will include instruction and 'walk throughs' of dances when required during the socials).

Dance workshops with dance instruction for all levels (beginner, improver and intermediate) on Saturday morning and some free time on Saturday afternoon.

This weekend will be tailor-made to those attending, ensuring you will spend plenty of time on the dance floor with a dance program including dances for all levels from beginner to intermediate. Each person who books will be able to request a certain number of their favourite dances & I will do my best to include as many as possible.

You will have the opportunity to socialise with your friends as well as getting to know other people within our club who you don't know so well ©

The cost is £154 per person based upon 2 people sharing (single supplement charges will apply). In order to secure a place we will need a completed booking form and deposit of £25.00. The closing date is 1st September 2019.

Places will be allocated on a 'first come first served' basis. There are a limited number of total spaces and only a small number of single rooms available so they are likely to sell out fast.
