

Visitors are welcome - a fee applies.



The group is over 50 years old and is open to practising artists who work in all the popular media and beginners are very welcome, as is anyone with an interest in and a love of art.

Membership costs £25 a year and £15 for full-time students.

Except in July and December the group meets on the fourth Wednesday of each month at 7.30pm at the United Reformed Church, Harestone Hill, Caterham CR3 6SX, when we have demonstrations by professional artists, the occasional miniworkshop, and informal painting sessions while in December there is a Christmas social.

If you are not sure about joining, come along to a demonstration as a visitor - a £4 per session charge applies - and see what we are all about. If you decide to join that evening we refund the charge.

A sketching group meets during the summer on a monthly basis at various venues in London, Surrey and Kent. We also hold Saturday workshops and arrange visits to art galleries.
