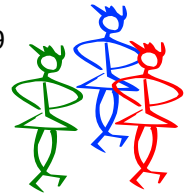

We danced until just after 11pm, looking forward to learning new dances at the workshops the following morning after breakfast.



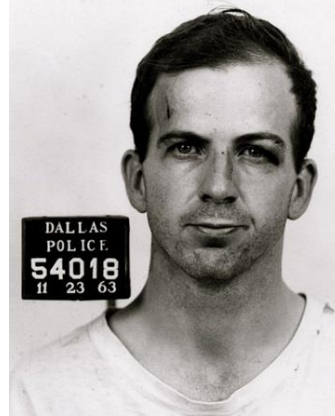

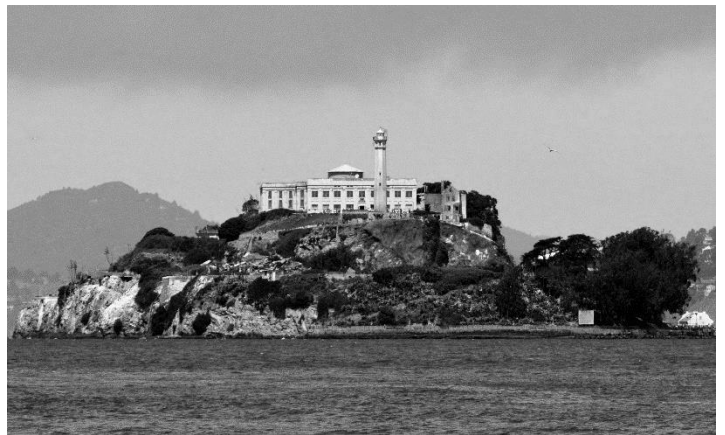

**SALUTI** – 64 count, 2 wall, intermediate level line dance choreographed by Karl-Harry Winson & Robbie McGowan Hickie – this dance went down very well and got a big ‘thumbs up’ from our dancers

The second workshop dance was **Rock It** – a 32 count, 4 wall dance choreographed by Julia Wetzel to the track ‘Rock It’ by Ofenbach – no tags or restarts but a little step change on walls 3 and 7 and counting to 4 in Spanish!

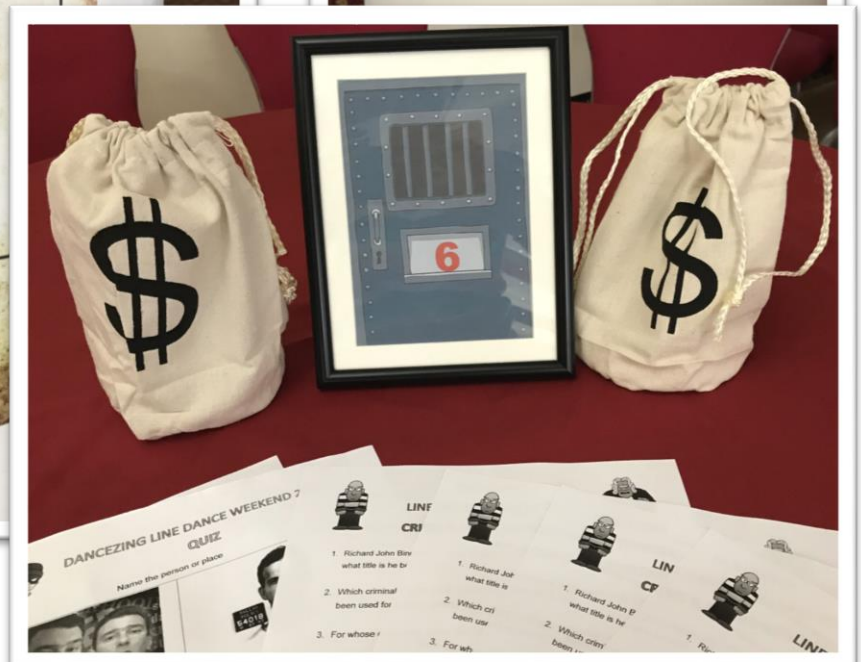
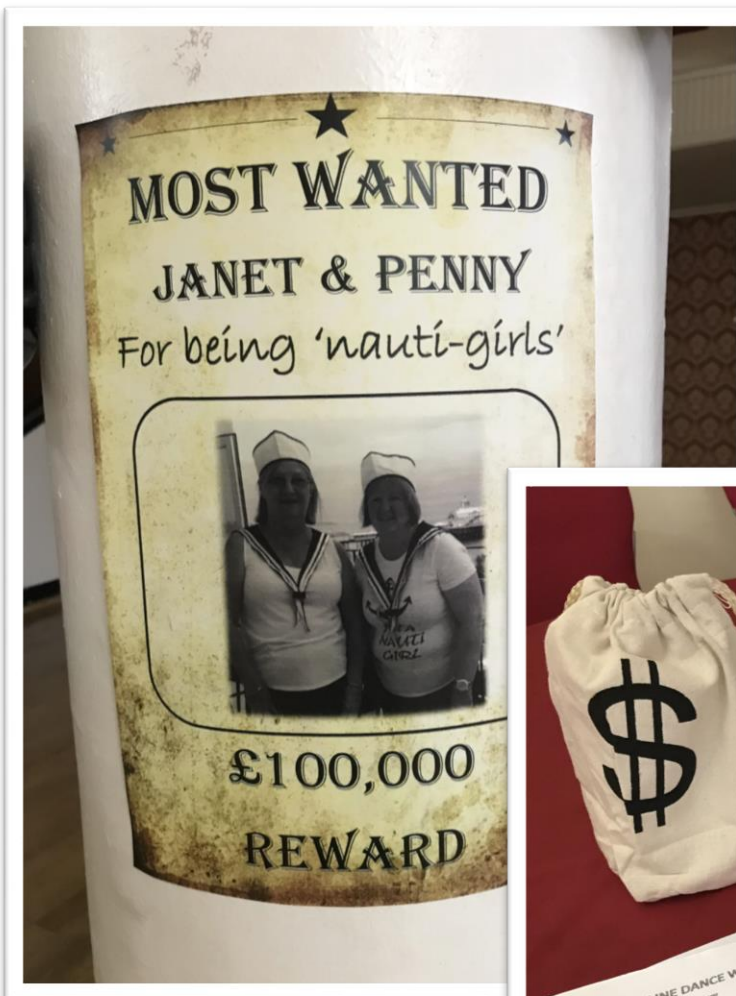
Everyone did a great job of learning the new dances and it was good to see our new beginners doing so well and it was heart-warming to see our more advanced dancers so keen to help others.
