## Would you like a Wineberry? by Heather Bailey

Some of you may know that I enjoy growing, eating and making jam with soft fruit - raspberries, tayberries, strawberries and blackcurrants which I grow in my garden.

A few years ago I read a description in the R.H.S.
magazine for a fruit I had never heard of, called a Wineberry. Sounds
 tempting doesn't it, and the flavor was described as "like a raspberry on steroids" - wow, yes I would like one of those!
So I ordered one from the plant shop at Wisley, collected it, planted it, fed it, watered it, supported it, and the following year was rewarded by a handful of quite small fruits.
Well, it was its first year. Give it a couple more years and the plant will grow bigger and hopefully the fruits will also increase in size.

Three years later the plant has certainly got bigger, the canes are now 10-12 feet long

But what about the fruits? No, the fruits have remained quite small, here are some on the right of the photo with my raspberries on the left for comparison - so you need to pick a lot of them to get enough for a decent helping.


And the flavour? Sadly I have been most disappointed. I would say they have less flavour, and they definitely have a higher proportion of pips to flesh than my raspberries. The other downside? They have VICIOUS thorns, not only on the stems but also on the underside of the leaves, which snare you as you try to pick them!
