This is Diana King (also Mum or Grandee).


- 9 months after suffering a bad stroke on the right side of her brain
- 8 months 27 days after having seizures and being put on end of life care
- 8 months 26 days after improving sufficiently to come off end of life care
- 8 months after catching Covid
- 7½ months after receiving the all clear from Covid
- 5 months after coming out of rehab
- 4 months after being told she wouldn't walk again
- 2 months after learning to walk with a stick
- 1 month after walking unaided
- 5 minutes after walking unaided up the stairs in her house


