I did try counting cross stich but couldn't see it very well.

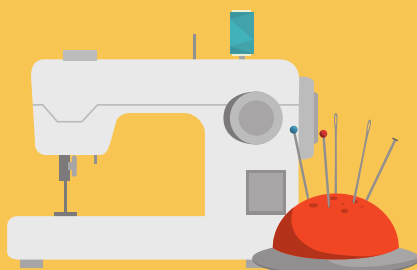
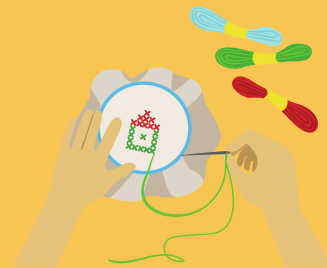
Reading is great way to pass a few hours. Love autobiographies and science fiction. Have reread some of my Isaac Asimov and Frank Herbert.

"During lockdown I have been; dancing (obviously) and have enjoyed learning new dances from your excellent tutorials.

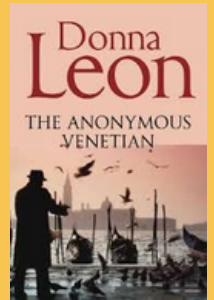

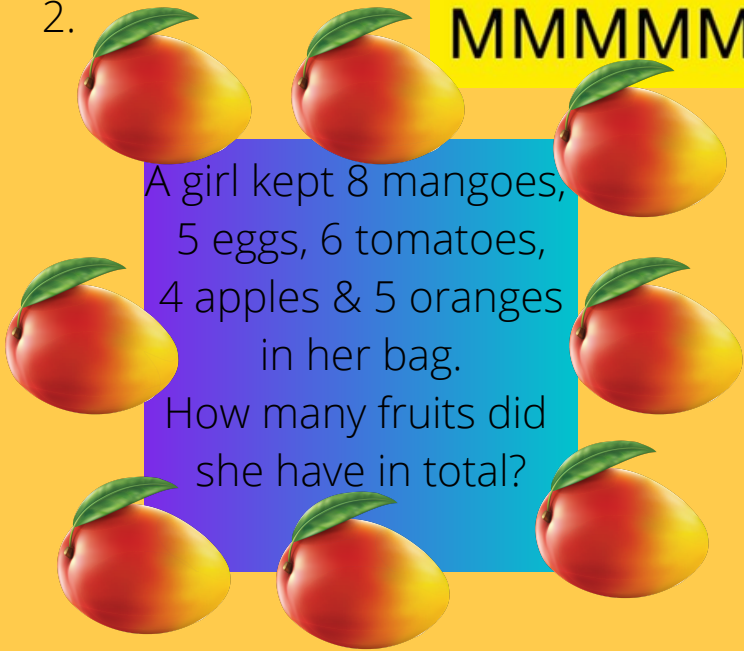

Corn = 25 (25+25+25=75), Popcorn = 20 (25 + 20+20=65), 2 o'clock = 2, (2+20+25 = 47), Final equation = 275 i.e. 75 + (40 x 5) because 5 o'clock is 5 4. Tank 6 because Tank 2 and Tank 7 are blocked, 5. Parking space number 87 - the car has reversed in so the numbers are upside down - 86, 87, 88, 89,90,91
