



DANCEZING - NEWS FROM HEATHER

What else was happening on Saturday 13th November apart from the Dancezing Social Night??

I'll give you a few clues: 8,000 people took part.....More than 500,000 people turned up to watch....It attracted a TV audience of between 2-3 million people

I was very honoured to be part of The Lord Mayor's Show, commemorating the election of the 693rd Lord Mayor of the City of London, Vincent Keaveny, who is a Freeman of both the Worshipful Company of City of London Solicitors and the Worshipful Company of Spectacle Makers.

The Lord Mayor's Show dates back to the year 1215, when King John granted a charter allowing the citizens of London to elect their own Mayor, on the condition that each year the new Mayor must travel from the City to Westminster to swear loyalty to the Crown. It has taken place every year since then, with the exception of 1852 for national mourning following the death of the Duke of Wellington, and 2020 when it was cancelled due to the Covid-19 pandemic. The outgoing Lord Mayor, William Russell has therefore served two years in office.

It is the world's oldest and longest civic procession, and is different every year because it highlights the interests and history of the new Lord Mayor. Vincent Keaveny's theme is "People with Purpose – Investing in a Better Tomorrow". I was parading with the Worshipful Company of Spectacle Makers - "People of Vision" involving various different sectors of the Optical profession. The sweatshirts we were wearing came in a choice of two sizes, Extra Large, and Even Larger than That!

We carried umbrellas with an eyeball design on them, sandwich boards, and a very large pair of spectacles which needed four people to support them:

Bob came with me, but was not allowed to walk in the parade. He did manage to pop up in several places along the route, taking photos, and even managed to gain access to our supposedly "secure" lunch area for a chat while we were standing around eating our provided pre-packed sandwich lunch, before heading off for his sit-down gourmet buffet lunch (including wine!) at Apothecaries' Hall.

All along the 3 mile route there were people waving and cheering, and several cub, scout and brownie groups blowing whistles, so there was a great atmosphere. Many people were videoing the whole thing on phones or i-pads, and we got about 15 seconds' coverage on the BBC, but their cameras switched shots just as I came into view.....



The return journey in the afternoon was delayed by almost an hour by some protesters who were apparently lying down in the middle of the route. I'm not sure how they were dealt with in the end, but as there were plenty of military and regular police, the Household Cavalry and various other mounted divisions, not to mention a few big guns, tanks and a combine harvester on hand to assist in moving them, I don't think they could have put up much resistance!

So that is why we missed Nicky's Social Night! After standing/walking for about 6 hours my feet were beginning to ache, and my arms were also tired from waving and holding an umbrella, but it was great fun.
