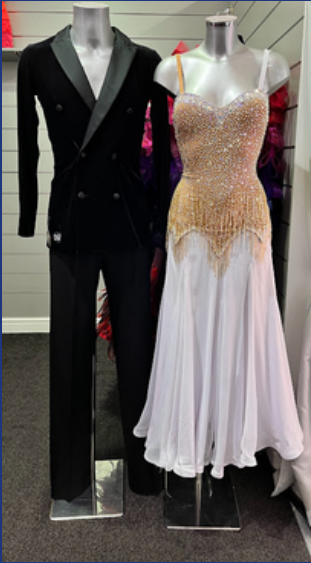
Of course, there is no need to move classes. This is an option for anyone wanting to challenge themselves but if you love your current class & wish to stay - that's great!

DANCEZING - BEHIND THE SEAMS TOUR

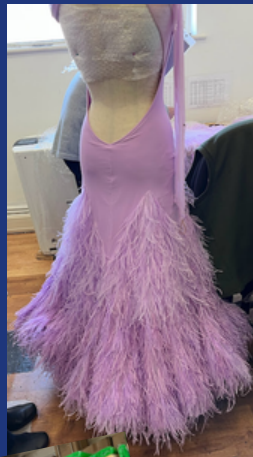
